



FOOD SERVICE WORKER

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Food Service Worker is in the front-end component of the dining services operation ensuring students, staff and other guests receive a pleasant and memorable experience. This person monitors setup, maintenance, cleanliness, and safety of dining areas. Reports directly Executive Chef and Head Chef.

TYPICAL DUTIES:

- Work in assigned area which may include, but is not limited to maintain and ensuring cleanliness of the following:
 - Cereal /Topping station
 - Toaster & beverage station
 - Servery and/ or dining room
 - Other areas of dining operation as necessary
- Wipe tables or seats with dampened cloths or replace dirty tablecloth
- Set tables with linens, condiments, or other supplies
- Scrape and stack dirty dishes and carry dishes and other tableware to kitchen for cleaning
- Clean up spilled food or drink or broken dishes and remove empty bottles and trash
- Perform serving. Cleaning, or stocking duties to facilitate customer service
- Maintain adequate supplies of items such as clean lines, silverware, glassware, dishes, or trays
- Stock cabinets or serving areas with supplies
- Locate item requested by guests
- Ensure that appropriate service and sanitation standards are being maintained
- Able to work at a rapid pace while maintaining attention to detail, ability to multi-task
- Must be skilled in time management
- Anticipate guest needs and ensure that service meet/exceeds expectations to ensure a memorable and pleasant dining experience
- Takes immediate action to correct any issues
- Assist with banquet set up and break down
- Report to work in uniform at posted scheduled time
- Proper use and care of dishwashing machine
- Ensures a clean and workable kitchen area at all time
- Perform general janitorial cleaning, such as sweeping and mopping floors, washing worktables, walls, refrigerators and meat blocks
- Re- stack cooks, line and dining room service areas with clean dishes, glasses and silverware
- Segregate and remove trash and garbage and place it in designated containers
- Steam-clean or hose-out garbage can



- Remove and break down any boxes from kitchen
- DISPLAY A PLEASANT DEMEANOR AND HELPFUL ATTITUDE IN ALL INTERACTIONS

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must maintain a high level of professionalism.
- Must show enthusiasm for the job and for MDPRC.
- Must be able to stand/ walk for 8 hours, bend, push, pull, lift 50 lbs.
- Must be able to work holidays, weekends and overtime as needed
- Must have a good self-image and be able to command the respect of the employees.
- Must be able to tolerate pressure and work calmly and efficiently during busy time.
- Possess the highest work ethics, personal morals and honesty beyond reproach.
- Pass a background check.
