GENERAL INFORMATION

- Arrival and check in from 3:00-5:45
 PM Friday. A supper in our dining hall opens the retreat on Friday at 5:45 PM followed by Orientation at 7:00 PM.
 The retreat closes Sunday about 12:30 PM.
- North of I-210, Mater Dolorosa is located in the San Gabriel foothills.
- The center has air conditioned rooms (doubles and singles) with private baths, library, gift shop/bookstore, Chapel, outdoor Stations of the Cross, amphitheater, and special places of meditation—the Garden of the Seven Sorrows, the Blessed Sacrament Garden, and a meditation pergola overlooking the Los Angeles Basin.
- Casual dress and comfortable shoes are recommended. Evenings tend to get cooler, please plan accordingly.
- Bedding, linens, and towels are provided. Please bring your own toiletries and hair dryer.
- Please inform the office in advance if you need a special diet, wheelchair or require a room to accommodate physical disabilities, etc.
- The suggested donation of the weekend is \$295 (which includes the \$50 deposit) for two nights' accommodations with five meals and conferences.
 - **Mater Dolorosa continues its longstanding policy of not turning anyone away because of financial need.



From the EB 210 Freeway. Exit on Rosemead / Michillinda, make a left on Colorado Blvd., a left on Michillinda Ave., a right on Sierra Madre Blvd., and travel east to Sunnyside Ave.

Turn left on Sunnyside Ave. and proceed to the end of the street and through the gates of the Retreat Center.
